The San Miguel Mission is the charitable mission provided by the Texas Podiatric Medical Foundation. The mission trips are generally five days and will involve flying into Leon, Mexico and taking a shuttle 1 1/2 hours into the mountain region to San Miguel de Allende. The clinic is held in conjunction with Casa hospital and involves clinic and surgical treatment for those in need from the region. Travel grants for residents are available depending on annual funding and donations. Approval of travel grant can take up to 10 days.
